



Nova Scotia Envirothon Rules and Regulation/Consent

- Students enrolled in Grades 9-12 during the current school year are eligible to compete
- Each team will consist of five members (with a minimum of four) from the same school and /or organization/association
- At least one team advisor or chaperone must accompany each team.
- Tobacco, drugs, and alcohol are **PROHIBITED**.
- Advisors will be responsible to assure teams display proper conduct during the competition and at the host facility.
- **All team members** must participate in the oral presentation.
- Judges decisions are final on all events.
- All team members and advisors must attend all scheduled functions.
- Team members are allowed to leave the host site without approval from advisors

NOTE: Rules for ALTERNATES - PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

If you have an **alternate** they are to be identified prior to the competition, arrangement will be made for this student to work with either other **Alternates** or under some type of supervision.

Alternates - Canon Envirothon

The **alternate** can only be added to the team prior to arriving at the Canon Envirothon.

Example: Joe an original team member gets sick in late July and can't go to the Canon Envirothon. Mary will take his place. The substitution can't be made on site. We do not have alternates at CE. Joe gets sick at the CE, the Canon Envirothon will decide if the team will be penalized for having only four members competing
